The mission of **CEAP** is to stabilize individuals and families in financial distress and to maximize their ability to live independently and with dignity.

Family Services are offered to help prevent crisis by providing food, clothing, financial assistance and other emergency services. Families living in CEAP service areas may be eligible for the following services.

- Back to School Program
- Holiday Program (Brooklyn Park)
- Community Advocacy
- CEAP Transportation Solutions Program
- Welfare to Work Transportation Program (Anoka)

Senior Services are available to persons 60 years of age or older or persons with disabilities. The programs' goal is to enhance the ability of individuals to maintain their independence while living in their own homes. (Brooklyn Park)

Meals on Wheels provides hot nutritious meals at noon to homebound individuals. (Brooklyn Park)
All meals are delivered by Volunteer drivers.

Senior Chores is a chore service program designed to help individuals with housekeeping, yard work, snow removal, and minor home maintenance. (Brooklyn Park)
